Your DNA—Who You Are

Location | Where has God placed you?

- Identify any pain points you're addressing in the community.
- How is the community impacted by the church's presence?

Culture | What do you value?

- In a typical week, where does the church focus its time?
- In review of your budget, where does your church focus its money?
- How is the heart of your ministry demonstrated?
- What do these answers reveal about the church's values?

History | Where have you been?

- How are you known in the community?
- List three notable moments in your ministry's past that point to where your ministry is going.
- Identify any growing pains the ministry has experienced. What was learned?

The Vision—Your Calling

Describe the bigger vision God has given you.

- Define the people group you are called to serve.
- How are you serving them? How are their lives being transformed?

The Mission—How You Are Stewarding the Call

You're on a mission. Define the types of leaders you need to advance forward. Think multi-talented and multi-generational.

What's the first step the church needs to take in order to advance the vision?
